- Students of Central Virginia Community College who have completed an Associate degree in radiologic technology and are successful on the ARRT exam in Radiography may apply to enter the Bachelor of Science in Imaging Science Program. They will be afforded the professional services of the Office of Admissions, Office of Financial Aid, Office of the Registrar, and the Office of the Bursar in securing necessary college admission and registration at Bluefield State College.
- Students of CVCC who enter the BS Imaging Science Program must apply for and meet the School of Nursing and Allied Health requirements for admission to the program that are to be found in the BSC Catalog.
- Students from CVCC will be permitted to transfer a maximum of seventy-two (72) credit hours to BSC. Included within this 72 hour will be a total of 35 credit hours for the Associate of Applied Science Radiography degree/certification, along with general studies courses that equal to no more than the permitted seventy-two (72) credit hours.
- The following counties in Virginia will be included in the BSC Metro Rate for tuition for students attending the BSC Imaging Science program: Campbell County, Bedford County, Appomattox County, and Amherst County. Additional counties included in the BSC Metro Rate can be found in Appendix B of this document.
- Bluefield State College Catalog graduation requirements must be met. All students must take a minimum of 32 credit hours from Bluefield State College in order to meet graduation requirements
- Bluefield State College Radiologic Technology/Imaging Science Faculty will conduct informal sessions for prospective students on an as needed basis.
